BIZ ASSESSMENT CALCULATION

\$0.003

per dollar of assessed value



\$0.058

per square foot of floor area



Annual BIZ Assessment

ASSESSMENT EXAMPLE

For example, a BIZ assessment for a property with an assessed value of \$100,000 and a floor area of 8,000 square feet is calculated as follows:

Assessed Value Rate: (\$100,000) x (\$0.003) = \$300



Floor Area Rate: (8,000)x (\$0.058) = \$464



Total BIZ Assessment: \$300 + \$464 = \$764



NUMBER OF PARCELS BY BIZ ASSESSMENT (2024)









■ 11% from 2022 to 2024




Are you familiar with the BIZ?




Overall attitudes toward Downtown Detroit


The sidewalks are clean and free from litter and debris
