



The Downtown Detroit Business Improvement Zone (BIZ) is a public body that works to create a vibrant Downtown through a variety of services made possible through the commitment and financial contributions of Downtown property owners. The BIZ, governed by a volunteer board of directors, contracts with the DDP to ensure services are maintained without interruption.


Ambassadors

The Downtown Detroit BIZ Ambassador program is the BIZ's largest program and the team's mission is to keep Downtown clean, safe, and welcoming to all, and to assist anyone they encounter with directions, support, and a friendly smile. BIZ Ambassadors are considered Downtown concierges and are easily recognized by their distinctive yellow jackets. Ambassadors are also trained in crowd control, de-escalation tactics, and mental health first aid.

RAP Program Projects

Downtown Safety

The Downtown Detroit Safety Ambassadors are trained and can call on the Downtown safety community, including the Detroit Police Department, for emergency and non-emergency assistance.



Safety Outreach Ambassadors

The Downtown Detroit Safety Ambassadors are part of Project Lighthouse[™] and are equipped with radios that allow the team to quickly call on the Downtown safety community, including the Detroit Police Department, for emergency and non-emergency assistance.



Project Lighthouse[™]

Project Lighthouse[™] is an innovative safety program that connects Downtown patrons to a network of safety partners ready and able to assist 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The 18 Project Lighthouse locations throughout the Downtown are identified using window clings with the Project Lighthouse logo.



CompStat

The DDP and BIZ convene a group of 65 law enforcement and private business sector agencies, including the Detroit Police Department to share timely. The goal is to prevent and suppress criminal activities.
