III. Work Session: Discussion to inform reauthorization of the Downtown Detroit Business Improvement Zone

Gina Cavaliere and Steve Liedel explained:

The process for reauthorization of the Downtown Detroit Business Improvement Zone requires the following steps:

- 1. Draft new Zone Plan.
- 2. Mail to owners of assessed property with invitation to attend a meeting of the BIZ board to vote on reauthorization.
- 3. Individuals present to vote must come to board meeting with evidence of authority to vote on behalf of the property owner.
- 4. With successful vote, plan is forwarded to Mayor and City Council for concurrence.

Regarding timing, approval is needed before end of current authorization period in April 2024. The BIZ Act still needs correction. The Detroit organizations who have or are pursuing BIZ's, plus Ann Arbor and

Grand Rapids, are actively working with respective lobbyists and legislators to move the legislation forward that made it mostly through the legislative process in 2022 and must be reintroduced.

The board discussed the contents of the proposed Zone Plan for the first reauthorization period and agreed:

1. The Zone boundaries do not change.

2. The Board of Directors will be updated to reflect the current BIZ board, contingent upon confirm

by each member that he or she agrees to continue to serve.

3. The board prefers to keep the assessment formula as-is. The data pull date will be adjusted at

the request of the City Assessor to align with city record keeping and the preparation of the

summer tax bill.

4. Projects listed in the 2014 Zone Plan will be proposed without change. The Board will continue

to review and document priorities with annual reviews of Scopes of Services and through the

annual budgeting process.

The Vice Chairperson asked for a motion to adopt everything discussed today into a package for the

board to review at our next regular meeting on February 28.
