


- **Detroiters:** The "Detroiter Profile" group are individuals who received an exclusive mailing asking that they complete the Downtown Detroit Perceptions Survey. The mailings were selected at random, and the results are weighted to align more accurately with the demographics of Detroit residents overall.
- The Tally: Data marked as "The Tally" indicates results from a survey invitation that was available more widely from sources such as email solicitation, Facebook and radio advertisement, and accessible to both Detroit residents and non-Detroit residents. The results include all results without weighting.

NUMBER OF PARCELS BY BIZ ASSESSMENT




