


Key Messages

- Lane Closures continue on WB Jefferson through the downtown
- Grand Prix Track Build Out begin on Jefferson on Sun, 5/18
- Construction continues on Randolph and Monroe Streetscape Projects
- NB M-10 Closure Fri, 5/9 PM through Sun, 5/11 PM from downtown to I-75
- Expect heavy vehicle and pedestrian traffic downtown Mon, 5/12 Thurs, 5/15 downtown as City hosts Automate Conference at Huntington Place
- Expect heavy vehicle and pedestrian traffic downtown on Saturday, 5/24 as City hosts Movement Music Festival, Tigers/Guardians, and concerts at Ford Field and Fox Theater
- Grand Prix Race Week Full Closures on Jefferson begin Mon, 5/26

MAY 2025

MARCH 10, 2025 – NOVEMBER 2025

Randolph from Jefferson to Gratiot

- Project: Randolph Streetscape
- Project Owner: City of Detroit | Department of Public Works
- Project Impacts:
 - Lane Closures
 - One Lane Open in Each Direction between April and September
 - Parking Restrictions along Randolph

MARCH 18, 2025 - JUNE 2026

Monroe from Randolph to I-375 - Updated May 2025

- Project: Monroe Streetscape
- Project Owner: Greektown Neighborhood Partnership | ENG 25-115
- Project Impacts:
 - Full vehicle closure of Monroe btw Randolph and St. Antoine
 - Now Dec 25: Full vehicle closure of Beaubien btw Lafayette and Macomb
 - Now Dec 25: Full vehicle closure of Brush btw Lafayette and Macomb
 - Now Jun 17: Intersection Closure at St. Antoine
 - St. Antoine to be converted to 2-way traffic during construction
 - Pedestrian Access Always Maintained
- Access Notes:
 - 400 Monroe Wayne County Pick up/drop off should utilize Lafayette between Brush and Beaubien
 - On-street parking available on Lafayette, Fort, Macomb, Beaubien
 - Greektown People Mover Stop Open (and Free to Use)
 - Greektown Casino Parking Access from I-375 and Macomb

OCTOBER 2024 – OCTOBER 2025

Broadway from Grand River to Gratiot

- Project: Broadway Lofts | ENG 24-1220
- Project Owner: Roncelli Construction
- Project Impacts:
 - Full closure of WB Broadway between Grand River and Gratiot
 - Limited sidewalk access on north side of Broadway
 - Traffic should use SB Randolph to SB Monroe to Woodward

May 2, 2025 – June 13, 2025

WB E. Jefferson Avenue near M-10 - Updated May 2025

- Project: Detroit Grand Prix
- Project Impacts: (Estimated Dates)
 - <u>5/9 5/12:</u> Triple Lane Closure WB Jefferson between I-375 and M-10
 - <u>5/5 5/17:</u> Street Closures around Renaissance Center for Track Build-Out
 - 5/18 5/22: Night-Time Closures of Jefferson for Track Build-Out
 - <u>5/26 6/1</u>: Full Closure of EB/WB Jefferson for Race Week
 - 6/5: Jefferson reopens in both directions
 - <u>6/13:</u> All other streets reopen

May 9, 2025 – May 11, 2025

NB M-10 (Lodge) from Griswold to I-75 - Added May 2025

- Project: M-10 Lodge Resurfacing
- Project Owner: MDOT
- Project Impacts:
 - Friday, 5/9 9pm Sunday, 5/11 10pm
 - Full Closure of NB Lodge from downtown to I-75
 - Traffic will be detoured via E. Jefferson Ave to NB I-375 to SB I-75 to M-10.

JANUARY 1, 2025 – DECEMBER 2025

WB E. Jefferson Avenue near M-10

- Project: 2nd Avenue Extension (MDOT Permit)
- Project Owner: Huntington Place
- Project Impacts:
 - Lane Closures on WB E. Jefferson downtown
 - Lane Closures on SB M-10 approaching Larned
 - Exit Closure on NB M-10 at W. Jefferson
 - Exit Closure on SB M-10 at Larned (through 5/25)
