To help navigate, here are answers to commonly asked questions:

- <u>Downtown Detroit parks</u> are a place for the community to gather, so there are likely to be crowds gathered nearby at the moment of your proposal.
- You're welcome to propose at any point during park hours.
- Secure the ring! The park is not responsible for lost items.
- During the holidays, proposals are welcome in front of Detroit's Christmas Tree, on <u>the</u> <u>Rink</u>, or other publicly accessible areas.
- Our parks are programmed, public parks and staff are unable to accommodate private or specific proposal production elements, accommodations, or requests involving music, lighting, video, or other elements.
- Playing amplified sound or hosting an event or flashmob is prohibited. Décor, furniture, food and beverage (including outside alcohol), props, floral, candles, etc. is also prohibited. Contracting with third-party event or prop service companies is also prohibited.
